Zoning and Development Highlights



A new multilevel restaurant has been proposed for 114 Green Lane (Artesano). The MNC Zoning Committee recently heard plans for a proposed renovation by the current owners of Artesano. Similar plans were proposed several years ago but

were put on hold during covid. The proposal incudes two floors of open indoor seating and a third floor roof deck with a small bar and limited seating. The owners are seeking variances for use, parking, and a roof deck, as the current location is zoned I-2 industrial.
