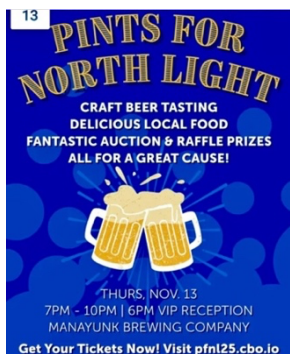
## Thanksgiving Day Parade

Thursday November 27 9am

The Philadelphia Thanksgiving Day Parade, the first and oldest in the country, will be held on Thanksgiving Day, November 27, 2025, with the theme "Holiday Magic". The parade starts at 9am and generally runs to about noon. It will follow its traditional 1.4-mile route along JFK Boulevard and the Benjamin Franklin Parkway, starting at 20th Street and JFK Boulevard and ending at the Philadelphia Museum of Art. The parade will feature floats, balloons, marching bands, and entertainers, and will be broadcast live on 6abc and can be streamed on Hulu and ABCNewsLive.
